# Auto save function of photos/videos

The FlashAir App for Android<sup>™</sup> or iOS will download photos and videos from the FlashAir W-04 card automatically based on your setting. You can set the date and file type for automatic download.

- This function is available on the FlashAir W-04.
- Keep the connection with the FlashAir W-04 while auto saving is running. If the device in which the FlashAir W-04 is inserted is powered off, the connection will be lost, and the auto saving will be stopped. To resume auto saving, connect to the FlashAir W-04 again.
- Some operations may be needed to upload photos/videos to online storage services.

## How to set up Auto save of photos/videos

• Use the latest version of FlashAir App for Android or iOS.

#### Step 1

Open the FlashAir App for Android or iOS.

#### Step 2

For Android, turn on "Settings" > "Auto save of photos/videos".

For iOS, turn on "Settings" > "Application Settings" > "Auto save of photos/videos".

Set the start date and file types to save automatically.
